## Student Festival Application fees:

Solo/Concerto	<b>\$20</b>
Duo/Duet or Trio	<b>\$40</b>
Chamber Ensemble	<b>\$50</b>

## Accompanist's Fee:

An additional fee of **\$50** will be added for our professional accompanists. This fee includes a rehearsal and the performance.

## Application Process: Once you are logged In:

You can create an application for each student at the bottom of the pull down menu - [Registration Application](#)

You will have to specify the following information for every student to complete each application.

- The Student's Instrument (if you teach more than one)
- Performance type (solo, concerto, etc)
- Student or students ( if performing in ensemble)
- Required piece and choice piece
- Performing siblings of the student or students (For scheduling)

After all your students have been registered -

1. Please collect checks for all fees (solo/duet/etc. AND \$50 accompanist fee if applicable) from your students' parents, **made out to you.**

2. Please write out **ONE** check payable to the Schubert Club which includes your students' performance fees (solo/duet/etc.). Indicate on the check that it is for student performance fees and the number of students.
3. Please write out a **SECOND** check payable to the Schubert Club for ALL your students' accompanist fees. Indicate on the check that it is for piano accompaniment and the number of students being accompanied.
4. Please write out a **THIRD** check payable to the Schubert Club for your membership fee (\$65), if you are not already a member. Indicate on the check that it is for membership to the Schubert Club
5. Please mail **All 3** checks, one for all you student's registration fees, and a separate check for the pianist fees, and one for your membership to **Marjie Brake, Registrar, 46 Glenarden Road, Trumbull, CT 06611. NO PARENT CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
6. Please send All music for the accompanists to Moira Schur Craw, Woodwind/Brass and Strings Festival Chairman, before the registration deadline. 114 Westport Road, Wilton, CT 06897

**Music for the accompanist must be sent before the March 9th deadline.**

**Please put the name of the student and contact information for the parents on the accompanist's music so rehearsal times with the pianists may be arranged.**
